**Accreditation**

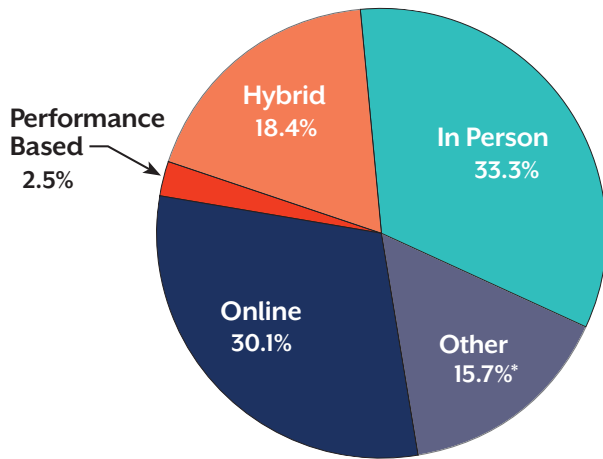
