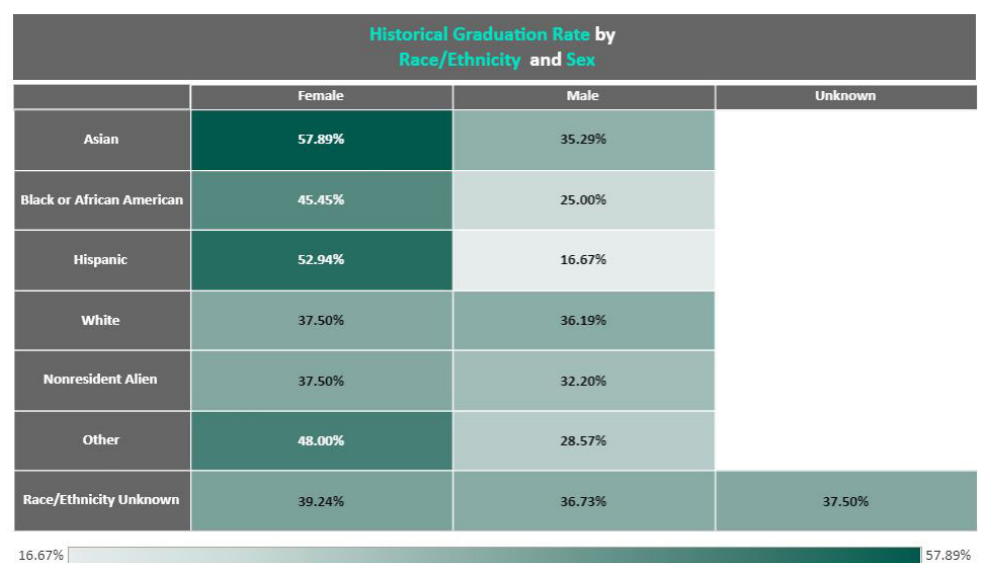
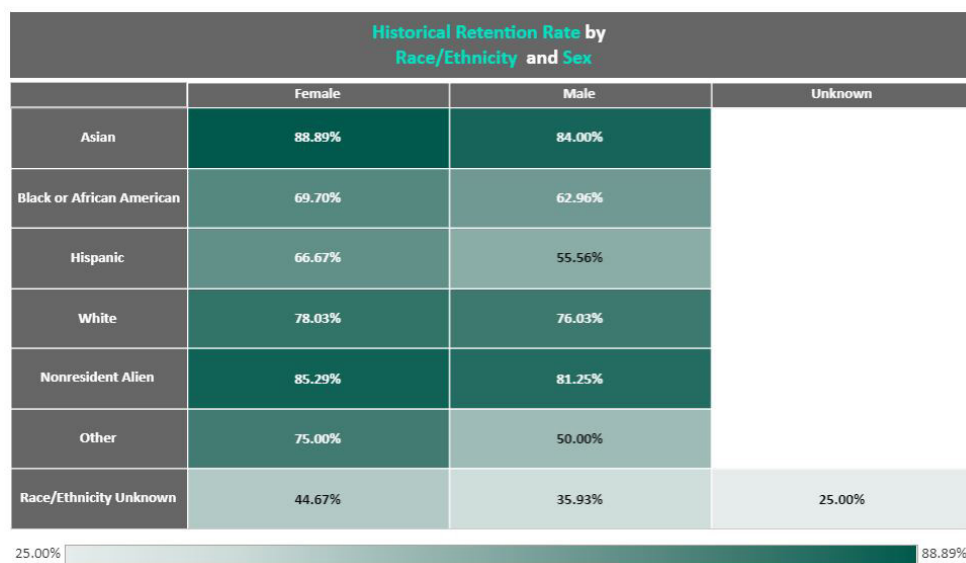
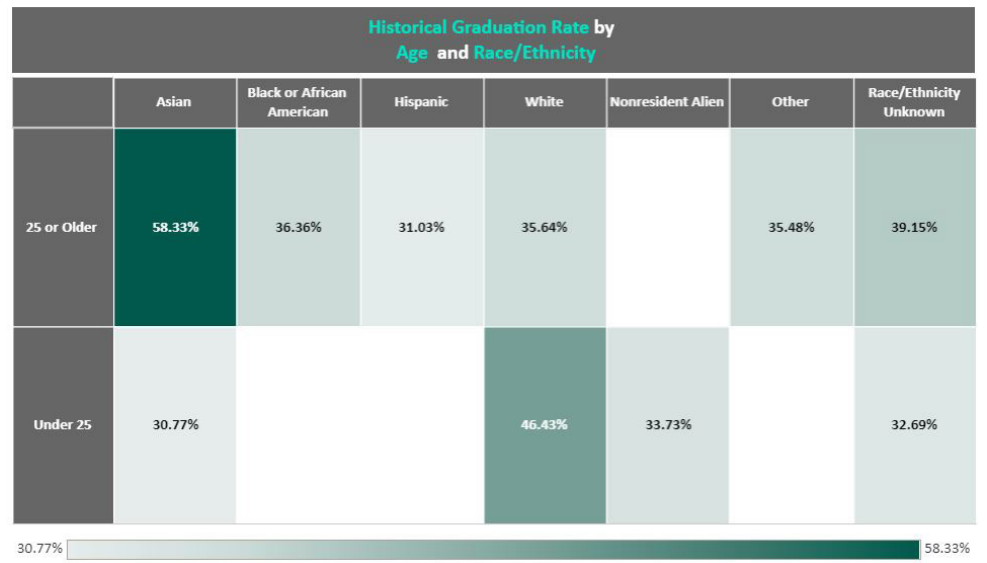
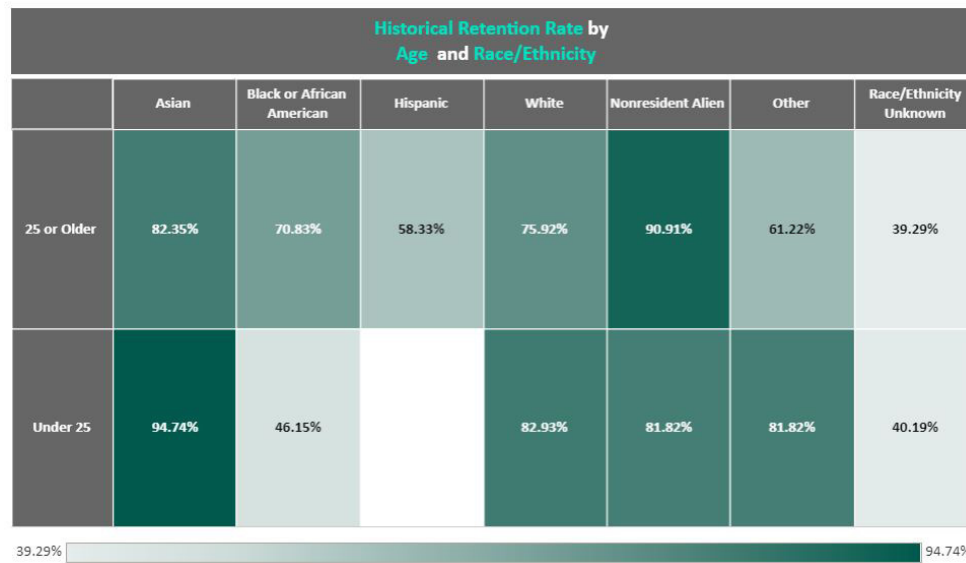


Student Success Data Disaggregated by Demographic Categories

As part of its commitment to equity and inclusion, CityU has begun a process to assess the success of students by analyzing retention and graduation rates by a variety of demographic categories. The university is in the process of developing an interactive tools that will show real-time data and that will allow users to explore a variety of dimensions within the data. While those tools are being developed, CityU engaged Hanover research to analyze 5 years of data from 2016-2020 for major trends that could be addressed as a starting point. The breakouts below represent some of the key findings.

The aim of this work is to identify gaps in achievements by specific groups so that we may better serve our diverse population and close those gaps so that all students are able to succeed at the same or similar rates. The CityU Retention Committee has already begun developing strategies aimed at closing achievement gaps identified in this data to better serve all students on campus.
